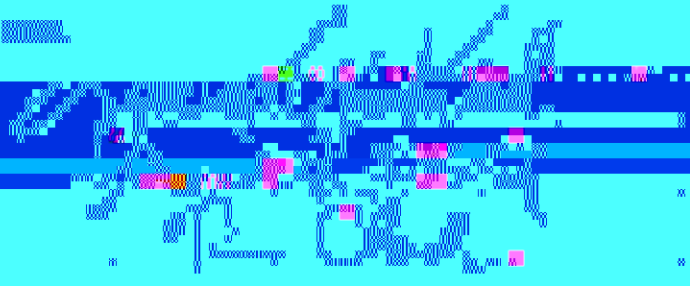
10. Board meetings are where the board does its work in public. We agree to speak to the issues on the agenda. Facts and the information needed from the audience are:
